3. Signs in Residential and Rural Zones

b. Signs Allowed by Special Exception

(5) **Off-premise signs for non-profit organizations:**

Government, religious, fraternal, and other non-profit organizations may erect one (1) off-premise sign for the purposes of directing traffic to the location of the non-profit organization. Such sign, if approved by the Commission, shall be placed on a Town street sign. The size, design, and materials used shall be consistent with the Unified Traffic Control Manual. In no case shall a sign exceed 2 square feet in area. All signs shall be made and installed by the Town of Avon Department of Public Works. The cost of manufacturing such signs shall be borne by the applicant. The Commission shall determine whether the location of the non-profit organization warrants a directional sign for reasons relating to public safety.
